The NEW Masonic Library and Museum is pleased to let you know that they are joining the Brown County Federation of Historical Museums. The networking potential of working with the over 12 organizations that currently comprise the membership is endless. A Federation board meeting was held at the Masonic Center the first week in October and the majority of the attendees spent considerable time in the Museum and enjoyed having a tour of the building.

FLASH! A BIG ACTIVITY OF INTEREST IS COMING TO THE NEVILLE MUSEUM.

The Initiated Eye: Secrets, Symbols, Freemasonry and the Architecture of Washington DC, traveling art exhibit owned by the Grand Lodge of Washington, DC will be at the Neville Museum in Green Bay between June 10th, 2017 and September 3, 2017. This exhibit explores the Masonic ideals and designs implicit in the fabric of our nation's capital. From the republican ideals made manifest in stone, to the carefully defined vistas linking famous heroes who were also Freemasons. *The Initiated Eye* offers an intriguing and architectural and historical perspective by combining artist Peter Waddell's paintings with seldom seen Masonic artifacts. This website shows 20 paintings in the collection – one of them is 5 ft by 5 ft and another is reported to have 80 inches as one of the dimensions.

Neville Museum will be using several artifacts from the Northeast Wisconsin Masonic Library and Museum to compliment their display. As we get closer to the date, more details will be sent via the Trestleboard. Needless to say, we are excited to have the display coming to Green Bay.

Brethren,

As I come to the end of my Year as Master of this great Lodge I want to thank all of you for your support and dedication to the Craft. I had given great thought on what to do my year and when I made the Masonic quiz program for Lodge I did so with the hope of giving you More Light in Masonry. I have seen members come and go in the Lodge in my short time and always wonder why they left and didn't come back. One of my thoughts was we didn't teach them more about Masonry. There are thousands of publications out there from great scholars such as Albert Mackey and Dr. Joseph Fort Newton. We need to study our history and understand its meanings to be better enabled to give to the newly made Mason instruction. We need to make our meetings meaningful and to constantly give more instruction. We know what it means to be charitable, we know how a meeting should run and all of us give back through our own deeds and also in the appendant bodies. I truly believe that the increase of membership to our Fraternity will come when we talk more about it with our current members and then they will get more members because they feel they are getting something from Masonry. We look to add members and want to get numbers up in our appendant bodies which is constantly talked about all the time. We can get members and numbers but will we get active members and will they stay? That is the question of all ages. There is a book that was published in 1969 named "Key to Freemasonry's Growth" by Allen E. Roberts. In one Chapter named "The Purpose of Existence" he talks of the past half century and how the American way has changed. What was good enough for the father and grandfather is no longer good enough for this generation. How the elections returns of the Hoover-Roosevelt race was listened to on headphones, computers tell who is elected before the last pole closes, something happening in California instantly viewed in Maine and this was described in 1969. Imagine the difference 47 years later in 2016 when kids 12 years of age have smart phones that fit in their hands far more advanced than the computers of the 60's, cars are driving them-

selves, email and texting immediately and paying your bills on-line. We can grow our Fraternity, we can get members engaged and we can have members attend lodge if we can remember one thing. Dr Joseph Fort Newton said "Freemasonry's simplicity, its dignity, and its spirituality sustain me in all that I try to do, and permits me to forget the incredible pettiness of mind that we sometimes encounter, sustaining me an enabling me to join hands with my brethren everywhere, to do something, if it be only a little, before the end of the day, to make a gentler, kinder, and wiser world in which to live". "The purpose of Freemasonry?" asks Dwight L. Smith. "Its purpose is the same as it has been since the day when the stones for King Solomon's Temple were hewn, squared and numbered in the quarries where they were raised. It is to take an individual - just one man at a time, mind you, and as good a man as possible - and try to make a better man of him. That is all. How desperately the world needs just that! And if that technique is outdated, then the experience of two thousand years is all wrong; the Parable of the Mustard Seed is horse-and-buggy philosophy; the Leaven in the Loaf is a cruel hoax. The mere fact that men don't comprehend its purpose does not mean that Freemasonry has no purpose, nor that its purpose is outdated - it only means that the stones [members] are not being well-hewn and squared in the quarries [lodges] where they are raised. Making men better has lots of meanings and room for the Lodge to act, there are many, many ways in which men want to become better. Throughout the ages Masons have been taught to be better men by loving one another; by being charitable to all mankind; by being faithful husbands and fathers; by being loyal citizens; by living a righteous life; by assisting not only each other, but everyone deserving of assistance, and the list goes on; but above all, they were taught to be better men by being moral and by loving God. Thank you all brethren for making my year great.
